Terms and conditions for participation in the International scientific conference "Young Researchers for the Regions"

Young researchers from Russian and international universities under the age of 30 are eligible to participate: undergraduate and postgraduate students, young scientists without an academic degree, students of schools (grades 10 - 11) and institutions of secondary vocational education of the Vologda Oblast.

Form of participation:

- for participants from the Vologda Oblast in person or remote;
- for participants from other regions of Russia and abroad in person, remote and in absentia (publication of abstracts in the collection of Conference papers).

Article Requirements

Abstracts of **no more than 2 pages** should contain the author's (authors') own research results. Abstracts should be **structured and reflect novelty**, **aims and tasks**, **objects**, **methods and results of the research as well as conclusions**.

Word processor – Microsoft Word 2007; A4 format, font – Times New Roman; font size – 14 pt; line spacing – 1,0; margins: top, right, left – 2 cm, lower – 2,5 cm; paragraph indent – 1,0 cm.

The title of abstracts (**no more than eight words, without contractions and abbreviations**) is typed in the center of the line in capital letters without hyphenation; below in the right corner in lowercase italics - the initials and surname of the author (authors - no more than 3), on the next line - initials and surname of the academic supervisor indicating the academic title; below - the name of the educational institution; next line - city; after an interval - text.

- Automatic hyphenation, text alignment justified.
- Formulas in the text are typed in the formula editor, papers with formulas in the form of images are not accepted.
- Font size of the tables 12 pt.
- Drawings, images, diagrams should be black and white, clear (photos are not accepted).
 Captions are written in italics, size 12 pt.
- If there is only one scheme, table or diagram in the abstracts, it is not necessary to number it. If there are more than one images in the abstracts (charts, tables, diagrams), please, carefully check the numbering to avoid mistakes.
- Bibliography should not exceed two titles. References to literary sources in the text are given in square brackets: [1], [2].
- A bibliographic list is formatted in accordance with GOST 7.0.100-2018, placed at the end of the text and separated from it by an empty line without a title.

According to the results of the Conference a collection of Conference papers will be published. The edition will be assigned ISBN, UDC and LBC codes and registered in Russian scientific citation index.

The collection will include the abstracts of the participants' reports after undergoing preliminary scientific selection, checking the texts for incorrect borrowings (plagiarism), and for the participants from the Vologda Oblast after a presentation at the Conference section.

Terms and conditions for participation in the All-Russian (with international participation) competition of scientific and technical translation

Bachelor's degree, specialist's degree and master's degree students of full-time and part-time education from Russian and international universities with sufficient knowledge of Russian, English and/or German are eligible for participation (no age or specialty restrictions). Professional translators and teachers are not allowed to participate in the competition.

Competition deadlines:

The qualifying round of the Competition is held remotely from February 15 to March 12, 2021. The results of the Qualifying round will be summed up by March 19, 2021.

The final of the Competition is held on April 17, 2021, remotely. Results will be summed up and the winners will be awarded on April 21, 2021.
